STRUCTURE & GUIDELINES

REGISTRATION: Registration will stay open until the start of level 10 on Day 1. One re-entry / lifeline per player will be available up to the start of level 10 on Day 1.

LIFELINE: There is one optional lifeline available to each player which can be used as a re-entry, re-buy, top-up or add-on; it costs R5 000 for 50 000 chips (see the tournament director for further details). The lifeline must be used prior to the start of level 10 and is refundable if not used. Any unused lifelines must be returned for a refund before the start of level 10 in order for the prize pool to be finalized.

DAYS: Players may play in more than one Day1. The highest chip stack will be carried forward to Day2

LEVEL TIMES: All levels will last 30 minutes.

DAY 1 will play a total of 15 levels.

DAY 2 will play down to final table or till the end of level 24.

DAY 3 will play down to the winner.

*All tournament levels increase by 10 minutes when we reach the final table.

RE-DRAW: Re-draw will happen at the end of day 1, the end of day 2 and at final table.

ANTE FORMAT: A single ante will be posted by the player in the big blind in the amount equivalent to the big blind of the current level. The ante is posted before the big blind and players are eligible to collect the entire ante even when not in the position of the big blind.

There will be a 3% staffing fee.

Tournament director reserves the right to change the scheduled end of day.

All break times are an estimate and are dependent on start times or any unforeseen hold ups.

Montecasino and Shuffle Poker reserve the right to change or cancel any event at any time.
